Miami Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women Scholarship Fund 2017-2018

PURPOSE: The Miami Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women (MACCW) Scholarship Fund was formed to give financial assistance to 8th grade girls, attending a Catholic Elementary School in the Archdiocese of Miami, to continue their education at a Catholic High School.

PROCESS: Applications are sent out each year to Principals of Catholic Elementary schools with an eighth grade. The completed applications must contain a recommendation from her Principal, signed by her pastor. The applications are judged by the MACCW Scholarship Committee.

OUR STORY: The MACCW Scholarship Fund was established in 1996 with the approval of the MACCW Board. The first official fund raising function was a Gala Dinner and Auction at the Ft. Lauderdale Museum of Art in February 2000. In 2015, the scholarship was named the MACCW Lucy Petrillo Scholarship Award, in memory of a founding member and longtime Chairman of the MACCW Scholarship Committee. Since 1996, over \$248,000.00 has been awarded to deserving young ladies.

The MACCW Scholarship Fundraiser on February 25, 2017, honored Archbishop Curley Notre Dame High School Principal, Mr. Douglas Romanik, (right) for making a difference in the field of education in the Archdiocese of Miami.
